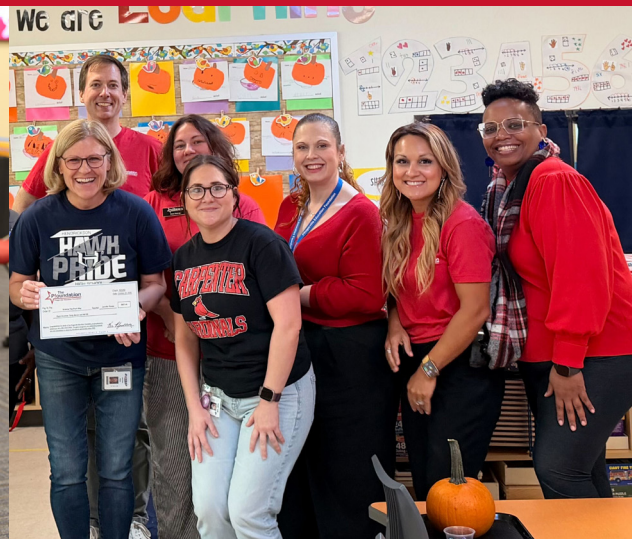

Karl Spencer is an accomplished nonprofit and higher education professional with more than two decades of experience advancing educational access, equity, and community impact. As a collaborative leader, he has built strong partnerships, implemented innovative programs, and led fundraising initiatives that have strengthened organizations and transformed student experiences.

Most recently, Karl served as Assistant Director of Outreach and Scholarships at the University of Texas at Austin's McCombs School of Business, where he managed more than 600 internal scholarship programs and led outreach strategies to expand opportunities for underrepresented students. In this role, he partnered with university leadership, alumni, and community organizations to enhance student engagement and financial support.

Previously, Karl served as President of 100 Black Men of Austin, where he grew the organization's budget through sponsorships, grants, and community events. He launched impactful programs such as the Saturday Leadership Academy and Cultural Competency Initiative, which empowered students and educators through mentorship and inclusive education.

Karl's earlier experience includes administrative and program management roles at Northwestern University and Enviromedia Social Marketing, where he strengthened operations, coordinated major events, and led diversity and inclusion initiatives.

A graduate of the University of Northern Iowa, Karl is deeply committed to educational excellence, community service, and leadership development. His volunteerism includes serving on boards for Big Brothers Big Sisters and First Tee Golf, as well as leadership roles on diversity and inclusion committees at UT Austin.

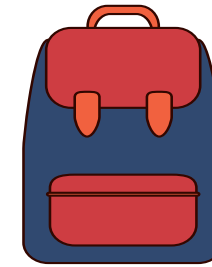

Tailgating on the Tees

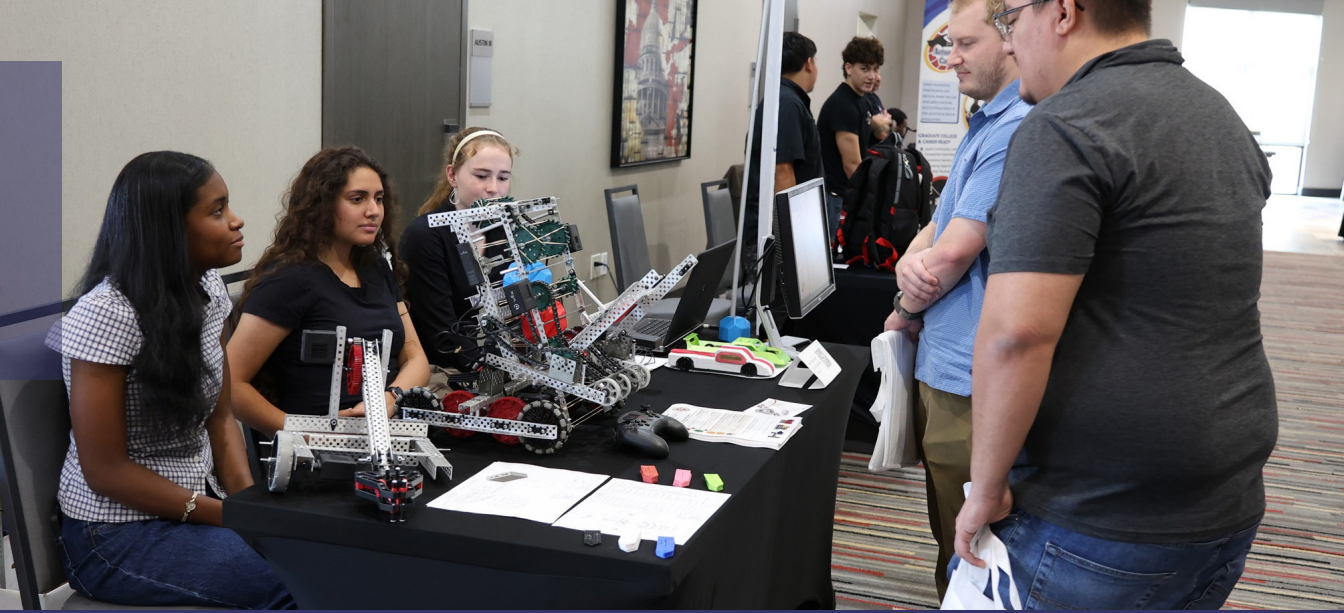
\$100,000 Raised
